Spiritual Gift Assessment Key

A. EXHORTATION:	The divine enablement to proclaim God's truth with power and clarity in a timely and culturally sensitive fashion for correction and repentance.
B. TEACHING:	The divine enablement to understand, clearly explain, and apply the Word of God to the lives of listeners.
C. ENCOURAGEMENT:	The divine enablement to reassure, strengthen, and affirm those who are discouraged or wavering in their faith.
D. EVANGELISM:	The divine enablement to effectively communicate the message of Christ to unbelievers so they can respond in faith and discipleship.
E. HOSPITALITY:	The divine enablement to care for people by providing for their needs with kindness and generosity.
F. LEADERSHIP:	The divine enablement to install vision, to motivate and to direct people to accomplish the work of the ministry.
G. MERCY:	The divine enablement to minister cheerfully and appropriately to people who are suffering.
H. SHEPHERDING:	The divine enablement to guide, care for, and nurture individuals or groups in the body as they grow in their faith.
I. ADMINISTRATION:	The divine enablement to understand what makes an organization function and the special ability to plan and execute procedures that increase the church's organizational effectiveness.
J. GIVING:	The divine enablement to contribute money and material resources to the work of the Lord with cheerfulness and liberality.
K. SERVING:	The divine enablement to attach spiritual value to the accomplishment of practical and necessary tasks which support the body of Christ.
