Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

- What does Paul say 'love is not'? (vs. 4-6)
- Instead of rejoicing in wrongdoing, what does love do? (vs. 6)
- What does love do? (vs. 7)

Discuss

- Describe how each of the negative characteristics that Paul mentions in vs. 4-6 are not loving.
- Which of these negative characteristics do you struggle with the most?
- How have you seen someone else act in love by bearing something or enduring a difficult situation alongside you or someone close to you?

Next Steps

- Reflect on how you have been prideful, arrogant, or bitter toward someone recently.
- Seek them out and ask for forgiveness.
- Consider a way that you could show someone love by coming alongside them and helping them this week.
