- What is unique about our High Priest? (Heb. 4:14-16)
- Compare and contrast the old covenant with the new covenant. (Heb. 9)

DISCUSS

- How does understanding Jesus as the High Priest encourage you to approach God with confidence in your prayers each day?
- What practical steps can you take to deepen your relationship with God, knowing that Jesus' sacrifice has provided us direct access to Him?
- Jesus sympathizes with our weaknesses because He was tempted in every way but did not sin. How does this truth comfort and strengthen you during trials or temptations?
