More Jesus
Acts 1 :1-11

The Holy Spirit's coming creates a shift in the hearts of the Apostles. People are cut to the heart and the Church walks in unity ministering to their community. Stories of transformation become commonplace. Luke's "history" lesson is the story of that new reality that altered all of humanity.

Initially, the disciples wanted to know when Jesus would return and the Kingdom be restored.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8

Acts 1:8 is the primary goal and purpose of the book of Acts. "You will receive power when My spirit comes upon you."
